He/she must recognize that they are an integral part of helping the members of GBC worship our God in spirit and in truth (John 4:23), and that they are to be using their gifts for the building up of the Church (1 Corinthians 12:7, 14:26). What follows is a **Statement of Commitment** that you must **agree with and sign** if you would like to be a part of the Greenridge Worship Ministry.

As a member of the Greenridge Worship Ministry I commit to:

- 1. Pursue an authentic and growing relationship with Jesus through consistent times of personal worship (i.e. through Bible study, prayer, serving others, sharing the Gospel with lost people, etc.).**
  - o “Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. <sup>5</sup> I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.” (Joh 15:4-5 ESV)
- 2. Covenant together with GBC by actively pursuing membership (if not already a member).**
  - o And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, <sup>25</sup> not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.” (Heb 10:24-25 ESV)
- 3. Participate with the rest of Greenridge in its mission to Connect with God, Grow together in our relationship with Jesus, Serve all people, and Share the Gospel.**
  - o “And Jesus came and said to them, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.’” (Mat 28:18 ESV)
- 4. Pray for and strive to exhibit a spirit of humility and gentleness when participating in the Greenridge Worship Ministry.**
  - o “Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. <sup>5</sup> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.” (Phi 2:3-8 ESV)
- 5. Be at peace with fellow teammates, dealing with conflicts that may arise directly, so that there are no hidden issues that might cause a division.**
  - o “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” (Joh 13:34 ESV)
- 6. Be faithful and on time for rehearsals.**
  - o “Whatever you do, work at it from your soul as for the Lord and not for me.” (Col. 3:23)
